The application fee (\$100 per pass holder and \$150 per greens fee player) for starting times must be received in full with this completed form. Applications must be received at Sunset Valley Golf Course Golf Shop, 1390 Sunset Road, Highland Park, IL 60035 no later than 5:00PM on March 6, 2010. Please call 847.432.7140 for more information.

### General Requirements:

- The lottery will be open for passholders and greens fee players. Any foursome enrolled in the 2009 lottery that returns at least two players are eligible to participate in the first drawing of the 2010 lottery. New foursomes or groups with one returning player are eligible for the second drawing.
- Each lottery group must be a foursome and can be made up of any combination of passholders or greens fee players. Each individual player is responsible for paying the appropriate fees for their lottery requirements.

### Passholders:

- Pay \$100 per person lottery fee and appropriate Season Pass fee for the time desired. Season Passes cover the individual for all green fees throughout the season. It is non-transferable. In the event that a passholders on a permanent tee time is unable to attend their scheduled time, they may find a replacement for their spot in the group. All replacements for passholders must be reported to Sunset Valley at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled tee time. All replacements must provide payment or proof of membership to Sunset Valley for the tee time.
- If a passholder is unable to attend and does not find a replacement for themselves, they must report this to Sunset Valley at least 48 hours prior to their scheduled tee time so that Sunset Valley may open the spot in the tee time to the public.

### Greens Fee Players:

- Pay \$150 per person lottery fee and all greens fees for the season (weekend green fees would be \$880, with weekday green fees totaling \$770 or \$572 for seniors). Greens fees will be paid in total at the beginning of the year. In the event that a greens fee player on a permanent time is unable to attend their scheduled tee time, they may find a replacement for their spot in the group. All replacements for greens fee players must report to Sunset Valley at least 48 hours prior to their scheduled tee time. All replacements for greens fee players reported in this manner will be considered as the greens fee player and will not be required to pay any additional greens fees.
- If a greens fee player is unable to attend and does not find a replacement for themselves, they must report to Sunset Valley 48 hours prior to their scheduled tee time so that Sunset Valley may open the spot in the tee time to the public.
- Any replacements for greens fee players that Sunset Valley find will be required to pay the required fees to Sunset Valley or show proof of membership.
- Any unreported replacements for greens fee players will be required to pay the required fees to Sunset Valley or show proof of membership.
- If Sunset Valley closes the course during permanent tee times due to weather, rain check policies will be followed for greens fee players. If a foursome elects not to play due to weather or elects to stop early, but Sunset Valley does not close the course, no rain checks for permanent times will be issued.

### Season Lottery and Reserved Starting Tee Time Information

- Lottery for reserved starting times will be held in three parts. The first drawing will be for the returning groups from the previous year on weekends. The second drawing will be for the new groups on the weekends. The third drawing will be for groups on weekdays.
- Reserved starting times are at 9-minute intervals starting at 6:00AM for Saturdays and Sundays. Season reserved starting times for Saturday and Sunday do not, however, pertain to holidays or during the North Shore Amateur.
- The starting time lottery will be held at 9:00AM, March 13, 2010 at the Recreation Center of Highland Park, 1207 Park Ave. West, Highland Park, IL. 60035. Only foursomes are eligible. If you need assistance in arranging a foursome, call Sunset Valley at 847.432.7140.
- At the beginning of the drawing, eligible groups are given a number and these numbers are placed in a single container then drawn one at a time. The representative for the foursome whose number is drawn will be given his or her choice of open starting times for Saturday or Sunday.
- At least one member of each foursome, or an individual representing that foursome, must be present at the drawing in order to indicate preferred starting time when the foursome's number is drawn.
- Reserved starting times are in effect from April 10 through September 12, 2010. Before and after the effected dates, times are available on a first-come, first served basis with reservations being taken up to one week in advance.
- Refunds are made only for the starting time fee deposit and prepaid greens fee, and not for memberships if a starting time is not drawn.**
- Permanent Times and Season Lottery.** Our season lottery foursomes are subject to the same "Keep Pace" system the course runs daily. The first half, or the first 11 weeks of the permanent times, each foursome must keep pace at least 2/3 of the time. Groups that do not keep pace 2/3 of the time are subject to moving their permanent time to the end of the lottery. Foursomes that do not keep pace 2/3 of the time for the season are not eligible for the lottery for the following season. The following maximum playing time criteria is used:
 

6:00 to 7:21AM	Must play in 3 hours and 50 minutes
7:30 to 9:54AM	Must play in 4 hours
10:03AM and after	Must play in 4 hours and 10 minutes

### Holiday Reservations

Reservations for Holidays (Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day) are available to all players on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations may be made on the Sunday preceding the holiday weekend.

### Phone Reservations

- Phone reservations are accepted for Sunset Valley Golf Course passholders seven days in advance beginning at 6:30AM. Passholders who make a reservation and do not play during the reserved time may lose their reservation privilege and are subject to be charged a greens fee.
- Greens fee players may reserve tee times four weeks in advance for threesomes and foursomes. These reservations must be secured with a VISA, MasterCard or Discover card. Cancellations may be made up to 48 hours before play with no charge. Groups not showing for their reserved times are charged for the number of players reserved.
