The performance runs from 4-6pm, please be available to skate at any time between 4 and 7pm. *Requests for a certain time can **not** be honored.* Every effort will be made to have a schedule posted by Monday March 18<sup>th</sup>.

**Music must be edited to the correct length of time, recorded on a C.D.** Using a standard length of music for each skater helps to make a more accurate schedule.

**Tot through Pre Freeskat Silver skater's music should not exceed 1:00 minute**

FS 1-6 level skater's music should not exceed 1:30 minutes.

There is a 10 second buffer for any program, that means if your program runs over the prescribed length of time it's o.k., as long as it's not more than 10 seconds.

Skaters above the Freeskat 6 level should keep music timed to their competitive program length. If you have passed the Freeskat 6 level and do not compete, The Skating Coordinators would be happy to advise you about the correct length of music.
