Mutual Friendship Request Form



Request Policy/Procedure for team formation requests

- Due to the nature of the program, we do not accept coach requests or carpool requests.
- The only requests accepted are Mutual Friendship Requests.
- Mutual Friendship Requests will only be allowed for the following programs:
 - Boys' and Girls' Basketball Leagues for Grades 1-2 (Jammers)
 - Baseball Leagues for Grades K-1 (Single A)
 - Softball Leagues for Grades K-1 (Rookie)
- Only one mutual friendship request per person.
- Both players must have the Mutual Friendship Request Form completed correctly and turned in by the registration deadline in order to be considered.
 - Both Mutual Friendship Request Forms must match each other. Example: Brian Smith and Eric Williams want to be on the same team. Brian's request form must have Eric's name and parent's name written on the lines provided and Eric's form must have Brian's name and parent's name written on the lines provided.
- When mutual friendship requests are granted and friends go to different schools, those players may not be on a team with players from his/her school.
- Siblings will automatically be placed on the same teams unless otherwise requested. Other family members (i.e. cousins) must complete the Mutual Friendship Request Form.
