Proposed Amendments to Fiscal 2015 Board-approved Budget

Background/Analysis

Each fiscal year, the Park District of Highland Park prepares its annual budget for the succeeding year. Sometimes unanticipated events that materially impact the budget occur after it has been approved. When this occurs, it is the District's obligation to prepare and approve a supplemental budget and appropriation ordinance. The lease approval with the City of Highland Park for operation of the Highland Park Country Club is such an event.

The purpose of this memorandum is to request that the Board of Commissioners support the attached changes and incorporate them into a Supplemental Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

Estimates, such as anticipated program revenue, that differ from expectations at the time the budget was prepared are not included in this document. Instead, only those items reflective of unanticipated revenue sources – such operational changes – or large, unanticipated expenditures (usually relating to capital or debt) will be included.

Legally, the Park District is required to prepare a supplemental budget and appropriation ordinance and proceed under the same formalities of the original budget and appropriation ordinance (public notice, public hearing, 30-day posting, etc.). If the Board agrees with the proposed revisions, the Public Hearing for the Supplemental B&A Ordinance will be held on September 29, 2015 prior to the scheduled Board Meeting.

Recommendation

Staff requests Board consensus to prepare a tentative 2015 Supplemental Budget and Appropriation Ordinance that is reflective of the budget changes proposed, and make the document available for public inspection for at least 30 days.

Background/Analysis

On August 25, 2015, staff presented to the Board of Commissioners the draft copy of the 2015 supplemental budget for the Park District of Highland Park. At that meeting, the Board provided consensus to lay down, for thirty days, the document for review as required by law. Further compliance was observed when notice of tonight's hearing was posted in the Lake County New Sun on September 17, 2015.

A hearing was held so that comments on the 2015 budget and appropriations ordinance from the public could be heard.

Attached to the memorandum in Ordinance 15-08 for fiscal year 2015. Staff requests a motion to approve the 2015 supplemental budget in the amount of \$33,261,522 (thirty three million, two hundred sixty one, five hundred twenty two) and to appropriate \$36,587,674 (thirty six million, five hundred eighty seven, six hundred seventy four) for the same fiscal year.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board approve Ordinance 15-08. An ordinance for a combined Budget and Appropriation for the Park District of Highland Park for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015 in the amounts of \$33,261,522 (thirty three million, two hundred sixty one, five hundred twenty two) for the budget and a related appropriate \$36,587,674 (thirty six million, five hundred eighty seven, six hundred seventy four).

ORDINANCE NO 15-08

AN ORDINANCE FOR A COMBINED SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION FOR THE PARK DISTRICT OF HIGHLAND PARK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2015 AND ENDING DECEMER 31, 2015

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Park

District of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, caused to be prepared
in tentative form an annual combined Supplemental Budget and Appropriation

Ordinance and the Secretary of this Board has made the same
conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty days prior
to final action thereon, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as to such Budget and
Appropriation Ordinance on the 29th Day of September 2015 and notice of
said hearing was given at least one week prior thereto as required
by law and all other legal requirements have been complied with,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE PARK DISTRICT OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the amounts herein set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law and as may be needed, are hereby budgeted and appropriated for the corporate purposes of the Park District of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of said Park District, as specified in Section 2 for the fiscal year, beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015.

SECTION 2: The amount budgeted and appropriated for each object or purpose is as follows:

Each of said sums of money and the aggregate thereof are deemed necessary by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Park District of Highland Park to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the foresaid Park District during the fiscal year beginning the 1st day of January, 2015 and ending the 31st day of December, 2015 for the respective purpose set forth.

SECTION 3: All unexpended balances of the appropriation for the 9 month fiscal year ending the 31st day of December, 2014 and prior years to the extent not otherwise re-appropriated for other purposes herein are hereby specifically re-appropriated for the same general purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency of any other items provided in this appropriation ordinance, pursuant to law.

All receipts and revenue not specifically appropriated, and all unexpended balances from preceding fiscal years not required for the purpose for which they were appropriated and levied shall constitute the general fund and shall be placed to the credit of such fund.

SECTION 4: Pursuant to law the following determinations have been and are hereby made a part hereof:

- (A) Cash on hand and short term investments at the beginning of the fiscal year: \$20,004,928
- (B) Estimate of cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources: \$22,731,835
- (C) Estimate of expenditures contemplated for the fiscal year: \$26,316,658
- (D) Estimate of cash and short term investments expected to be on hand at the end of the fiscal year: \$16,420,105

SECTION 5: All ordinance or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby modified or repealed. If any item or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of such item or the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is not intended or required to be in support of or in relation to any tax levy made by the Park District during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015, or any other fiscal year.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law. A certified copy of the Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk of Lake County, Illinois, together with the certificate of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Park District certifying revenues by source anticipated to be received by the Park District, within thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
