Subject: Consideration to Approve the Sunset Valley Golf Club Restaurant

Concessionaire License Agreement

Summary

The Park District of Highland Park terminated the restaurant license agreement with Open Kitchens Inc. at Sunset Valley Golf Club in December 2023. The Park District desires to partner with a new restaurant group that aligns with the Park District's values of welcoming, caring and extraordinary.

Madden Restaurant Concepts, LLC has experience in golf course food and beverage operations including currently managing operations for The Lawn at The Wilmette Golf Club as well as Left Coast Foods in Chicago.

Financial Impact

Park District staff has negotiated terms with Madden Restaurant Concepts, LLC for a five-year concessionaire license agreement to operate the Restaurant/Bar at Sunset Valley Golf Club. Annual License Fees will be paid monthly, beginning in July 2024 and over the course of the 5-year term will be \$230,000 and are outlined in the agreement. In effort to reinvest in the restaurant user experience at Sunset Valley Golf Club, as part of the License Agreement, the Park District agrees to commit the first 3 years license fee towards capital improvement projects to both the indoor and outdoor areas at the Sunset Valley Clubhouse.

Recommendation

Staff and the Facility and Recreation Committee recommend approval from the Park Board of Commissioners for the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with Madden Restaurant Concepts, LLC. beginning on January 18, 2024, and concluding on December 31, 2028.

Restaurant/Bar License Agreement

Sunset Valley Golf Club

THIS OPERATING AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 18 day of January, 2024, by and between the Park District of Highland Park ("Park District") an Illinois unit of local government and Madden Restaurant Concepts, LLC. ("Vendor"), a Delaware limited liability company, with its mailing address at 1200 Elmwood Ave, Wilmette, IL 60091.

RECITALS

- A. The Park District owns and operates an 18-hole golf course and clubhouse known as Sunset Valley Golf Club ("SVGC") at 1390 Sunset Road, Highland Park, Illinois.
- B. The Park District desires to issue a license to Vendor to operate all food and beverage sales and operate the Restaurant and Bar at Sunset Valley Golf Club.
- C. Vendor desires to accept a license from the Park District to operate all food and beverage sales and operate the Restaurant and Bar at Sunset Valley Golf Club.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, terms and obligations stated herein, the Park District and Vendor agree as follows:

- Recitals: The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as substantive provisions of this Operating Agreement.
- Term of Agreement: This Agreement shall commence on January 18, 2024, and shall expire on December 31, 2028, unless otherwise provided for by this Agreement.

- 3. Facilities: Vendor is hereby granted a Management License for non-exclusive access to the following facility for the term of this license agreement: Sunset Valley Golf Club Restaurant and Bar and on-course food and beverage service (the "Facilities"). While this agreement is in place, Madden Restaurant Concepts, LLC is the sole provider of food and beverage for Sunset Valley Golf Club and Course.
- 4. <u>License Fee</u>: The Park District and Vendor have agreed that Vendor shall pay to the Park District an annual license fee (the "Base Fee") beginning on the following schedule:

In addition to the Base Fee, the Park District will commit year one through three license fee to incorporate capital improvement projects to both the indoor and

outdoor areas at the Sunset Valley Clubhouse. All major License Improvements must be approved by the Park District prior to installation, including the material, color, design, and manufacturer. Installation and equipment specifications must comply with health department regulations and city permitting guidelines. All installation work must be performed by a Contractor approved by the Park District and comply with laws applicable to construction on public property and receive written consent from the Park District. The Vendor shall cause the Vendor's Contractor to provide the Park District with a certificate of insurance and name the Park District as an additional insured prior to the Contractor entering the SVGC. All License Improvements will be Park District property upon completion and acceptance by the Park District unless otherwise agreed upon in writing between the Vendor and Park District. Vendor is also responsible for all dishware, silverware, linens, and miscellaneous kitchen items.

License Fee Late payment: After 10 days, if the vendor fails to make the required payment on the due date, then the vendor will be subject to a late charge of \$15 per day (or \$105 per week) for each day any portion of the License Fee remains unpaid after the due date.

5. Hours of Operation: While this Agreement is in effect, Vendor agrees to open and operate the Facilities for the sale of food and beverages when the golf course is open for play or any special event. Vendor may close the Facilities early with the Park District's prior consent, which consent will not be

unreasonably delayed or denied. Please see **Exhibit B** for a detailed overview of the hours of operation.

6. **Food Items and Pricing**: Vendor understands that it is the desire of the Park District to offer to Golf Club patrons a quality menu consistent with considerations of sage and sanitary Golf Club facility operation, space and equipment limitations, cost and consumer demand. Subject to compliance with the applicable laws pertaining to the preparation and/or sale or delivery of Vendor is authorized to sell and serve food, hot and cold beverages, including alcoholic beverages. Any menus posted by Vendor shall be professional in appearance. In the event the Park District has an issue with a menu, the Vendor will make every reasonable effort to ensure that all menu items shall be available and in stock when open for business. Vendor's menu shall include the food items listed in **Exhibit C** attached to and incorporated by reference in this Agreement, with the exception that certain items may be modified within reason based on supply and demand. The Parties may amend Exhibit C from time to time by mutual written consent. The menu may expand or contract depending upon the foregoing considerations. Vendor shall not sell, or otherwise make available, any food or alcoholic beverage without first obtaining all required licenses and permits. Vendor shall be responsible to pay any and all fees, costs, fines and expenses relating to the issuance of any liquor license or permit necessary for the sale of liquor on the Premises, or arising from the sale or consumption of liquor on the Premises, including but not limited to facility liquor licenses, dram

shop insurance coverage reasonably required by the Park District in connection with the Vendor's sale of liquor on the Premises. Vendor shall post its menu in a place clearly visible to the public. The size, type, location, and method of installation of all signage must be approved by the Park District. For the ordinary operation of the Facilities (non-private events), Vendor agrees that the Park District shall approve items to be sold from the Facilities and the price to be charged for all such items within reason. The Park District's approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. Vendor and Park District agree to meet annually on menu and pricing to reasonably come to terms agreed upon by both parties.

7. Scheduling and Booking Events: Vendor agrees to supply food and beverage packages and adequate staff for golf outings and private events. Park District retains the right to book all non-food related events and room rentals if the restaurant is not open for business. Park District and Vendor shall collaborate in the development and adherence to a system for scheduling and booking events. Vendor is responsible for booking non-golf private or semi-private events where food service is requested. Park District may use the facility for Park District functions, meetings, and/or events at any time during the term of the agreement. The Vendor shall provide food and beverage services for Park District or Parks Foundation related events, programs, meetings (collectively, "Park District Special Events") at cost two times per calendar year during the term of this Agreement. At cost shall be 35% off what normally would be charged for any similar event and include the cost for food and beverage, labor, and other related

expenses. Licensee shall not charge the Park District or Parks Foundation a room fee or set-up fee for Park District Special Events. The Parties shall meet from time-to-time to discuss the Park District Special Events and shall mutually agree on the number, dates, times, and durations of the Park District Special Events. The Vendor agrees to provide Park District staff with a 25% discount on food and non-alcoholic beverages.

- 8. Marketing and Communication: Park District and Vendor shall use all reasonable efforts to market, promote and advertise the Restaurant and Bar. Park District will have the right to market, promote and advertise its facilities, including the Facilities, in any fashion that, in its sole discretion, determines to be in its best interests. Vendor marketing, promotions and advertising which can reasonably be attributed to the Park District or Sunset Valley Golf Club shall be subject to Park District review and prior written approval. The Park District also grants a limited, non-exclusive license to Vendor to use the Park District's marks, logos and copyrighted material only to the extent required to perform this Agreement, and subject to the aforementioned right of approval.
- 9. Access; Inspection: Park District shall retain keys to the Facility and shall provide Vendor with duplicate keys thereto. Vendor shall not change the locks or cause the locks not to work. The foregoing access rights of the Park District are not intended to create and shall not be construed as creating or imposing any affirmative obligation on the part of the Park District to inspect, maintain or repair

the facility, nor any liability on the part of the Park District for its failure to make any such inspections or repairs or to perform any maintenance function required otherwise to be performed by Vendor under this Agreement.

10. **Termination:**

- a. This Agreement and the License granted hereunder may be terminated prior to its expiration under any of the following circumstances;
 - i. In the event Vendor shall unintentionally breach or be in default, under any of the provisions of this Agreement (with the exception of Paragraph 12 or Paragraph 14), District may terminate this Agreement and License if Vendor shall not have cured (or commenced to cure in the event such breach of default is of a nature that it cannot be cured within ten business days) such default within ten (10) days after District shall have notified Vendor thereof in writing provided, however, that if Vendor shall have unintentionally breached or been in default under the same or any other provision of this Agreement within 90 days District may terminate the Agreement and License immediately without affording Vendor an opportunity to cure the breach or default, upon written notice to Vendor. Park District shall have the right to suspend Vendor's License during a cure period.

- ii. In the event Vendor shall breach or be in default under Paragraph 12 or Paragraph 14 of this Agreement, District may terminate the License immediately upon written notice to Vendor or in the case of Paragraph 12 may suspend the License until such insurance coverages are obtained, without affording Vendor an opportunity to cure the breach or default.
- iii. In the event Vendor shall have (1) filed a voluntary petition in bankruptcy or made an assignment for benefit of creditors; (2) consented to the appointment of a receiver or trustee of all or part of his property; or (3) an involuntary petition in bankruptcy shall have been filed in regard to Vendor and the same shall not have been dismissed within ten (10) days of such filing, the Agreement and License shall automatically terminate.
- iv. In the event District discontinues the operation of the Golf Club for any reason whatsoever, the License shall automatically terminate. In the event District suspends the operation of the Golf Club for any reason the License shall automatically be suspended for the same period.
- v. In the event the Licensed Space is rendered unusable by reason of fire or other casualty, the Park District may terminate this Agreement or elect to repair. If Park District elects to repair, this Agreement shall remain in effect, provided that if the Park District does not complete such repairs within thirty (30) days from the date of the occurrence of the casualty, Vendor shall have the option to terminate this Agreement.

- vi. In the event Park District shall fail to perform any of its material obligations under this Agreement, Vendor may terminate this Agreement and License if Park District shall not have cured (or commenced to cure in the event such failure is of such a nature that it cannot be cured within five days) such failure within five (5) days after Vendor shall have notified Park District thereof in writing. In the event of termination under this Paragraph 10, all rights of Vendor and obligations of Park District shall cease. Park District's right to collect sums due from Vendor under this Agreement and remedies for breach of this Agreement and Vendor obligations to make such payments and compensate Park District for such breach shall continue after termination of this Agreement and License.
- 11. Indemnification: Vendor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Park District, its officers, elected officials, employees, volunteers and agents against any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses, and suits of any manner, including but not limited to, legal fees (attorneys and paralegals' fees and court costs), arising from or in any way connected with; i) the Vendor's conduct or management of the Facilities or of any business or activity therein, or any work or thing whatsoever done, or condition created in or about the premises during the term of this Agreement; ii) any act, omission, wrongful act or negligence of Vendor or any of Vendor subcontractors (if applicable) or the partners, directors, officers, agents, employees, invitees or contractors of Vendor; iii) any accident,

injury, or damage whatsoever occurring in or at the Facilities regardless of whether or not it is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or otherwise reduce any other right or obligation of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to any party or person described in this Paragraph. Vendor shall similarly protect, indemnify, and hold and save harmless the Park District, its officers, elected officials, employees, volunteers, and agents from and against any and all claims, costs, causes, actions and expenses including but not limited to legal fees, incurred by reason of Vendor breach of any of its obligations under, or Vendor default of, any provision of this Agreement.

- 12. <u>Insurance</u>: In furtherance and not in limitation of its foregoing indemnification obligation, Vendor shall obtain and maintain at all times during the License Term insurance coverage written for not less than the limits of liability, and under all the other terms and conditions, set forth in **Exhibit D** attached to and incorporated by reference in this Agreement, and shall name the Park District as an additional insured with respect to all coverage.
- 13. <u>Independent Contractor Status</u>: Vendor acts solely in the capacity of independent contractor for the Park District and not as an employee of the Park District. As a result of Vendor independent contractor status, Vendor shall have exclusive control of its time (subject to the terms of this Agreement) and shall be responsible for the direct supervision of all of its employees, agents, or

subcontractors. Vendor agrees to remove any subcontractor from the facilities for inadequate performance as determined by evaluations submitted by the Park District and Vendor. Vendor shall provide all workers' compensation and unemployment insurance, payroll taxes and other related benefits for its employees as required by law. Nothing contained in or done pursuant to this Agreement shall be construed as creating a partnership, agency, joint employer or joint venture relationship between the Park District and Vendor. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Agreement, no party shall become bound, with respect to third parties, by any representation, act or omission of the other party.

14. Compliance with Laws: Vendor agrees to fully comply with all applicable
Federal, State and Local laws and regulations, and with all Park District rules and
regulations applicable to the operation and use of the Facilities, including but not
limited to all applicable codes, laws, ordinances, and regulations of the City of
Highland Park, the Park District of Highland Park, the County of Lake, the State
of Illinois, and the United States, including, but not limited to, health and
sanitation (food and sanitation certificate holder), minimum wage, prevailing
wage, workers compensation, drug-free workplace, sales tax, and equal
employment opportunity laws. Vendor shall be responsible for all sales and real
estate taxes arising as a result of this Agreement or any of Vendor activities
pursuant to this Agreement. Vendor shall, at its sole cost and obligation, be
responsible for obtaining all permits required to operate the Facilities, including

local and state liquor licenses and a food service permit from the Lake County Health Department. Vendor shall be responsible for giving notice to the Park District, at the address listed in paragraph 23, of all inspection results from any governmental agency responsible for public health, safety, and welfare. Please note that the food and beverage tax in Highland Park is 1% of the total sales. It is the responsibility of the Vendor to submit food and beverage tax to the City of Highland Park.

15. **Facility Conditions, Cleanliness and Sanitation**:

- A. Vendor agrees to maintain the Facilities, including but not limited to the bar, restaurant, indoor tables and chairs, outdoor tables and chairs, concession stands, food carts and related areas, in a clean, neat, and orderly condition at all times. Vendor shall make no modifications to any of the Facilities without the prior written approval of the Park District. Immediately upon termination of this Agreement for any reason, Vendor shall return the Facilities and any equipment contained therein to the Park District in the same condition as received, ordinary wear and tear and/or Park District-approved improvements (including the License Improvements) excepted.
- B. The Park District shall maintain and repair all structural and mechanical components of the buildings.
- 16. **Equipment**: Vendor: a) has examined the buildings and equipment prior to the execution of this Agreement, finds them to be satisfactory as outlined in **Exhibit**

A and accepts the Facilities in an as-is/where-is condition; b) acknowledges that no representation as to the condition or repair of any of the Facilities has been made by the Park District other than as expressly contained in this Agreement and it is relying solely on its own inspection to determine the fitness of the Facilities to perform Vendor's obligations hereunder; and c) acknowledges that no agreement or promise to alter, repair or improve the concession buildings or Facilities has been made by the Park District. At the termination of this Agreement for any reason, any equipment that is installed in the Facilities or becomes a fixture shall be retained by the Park District, or contracts pertaining to this equipment shall be assigned to the Park District. Vendor agrees to take all necessary steps to effectuate such assignment. Except as provided immediately above, title to all equipment provided by Vendor, except fixed equipment belonging to the Park District and listed on the schedule of fixed equipment, shall remain in the possession of Vendor and shall be removed by Vendor upon termination of this Agreement.

17. Service: Vendor shall cause its employees to take and deliver food and beverage orders to patrons at tables located in the restaurant area of the Facility. Vendor should also have an Operations Manager or Designated Manager on Duty on site to oversee the day-to-day operations and to communicate with the on-site Park District staff. Vendor shall provide its employees with an appropriate uniform that will be mutually agreed upon with the Park District. Vendor must require its employees to wear their appropriate uniform during their working shift.

- 18. <u>Trash</u>: Vendor shall be responsible for the disposal of trash generated by its operation on and at the Facilities. The Park District will contract and/or perform the off-site disposal of refuse generated by Vendor.
- 19. <u>Waiver:</u> Failure or delay on the part of either party to exercise any right, power, privilege, or remedy under this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver thereof. No modification or waiver by either party of any provision shall be deemed to have been made unless made in writing and signed by both parties.
- 20. **Severability:** The provisions of this Agreement shall be severable and the invalidity of any provision, or portion thereof, shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions.
- 21. <u>Authorized Signatures/ Effectiveness:</u> The persons signing this Agreement represent and warrant that they have all legal authority and power in their respective capacities to bind Vendor and the Park District and the Agreement shall not be effective until fully executed and delivered to all parties.
- 22. Entire Agreement and Amendments: This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all previous agreements or negotiations, whether written or oral, and shall not be modified or amended except by written agreement duly executed by and delivered to all parties.

23. **Notices:** All notices shall be in writing and shall be given by personal service or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, to the parties at the respective addresses set forth below or at such other address(es) as the parties may formally designate, in writing, from time to time.

- 24. **Assignment:** This Agreement shall not be assigned without the express written consent of the non-assigning party.
- 25. Performance Reviews: If the Park District determines, in its reasonable opinion, that the operations at the Premises are unsatisfactory, then Vendor agrees to meet at least once with the Park District within 24 hours of receipt of any oral or written notice from the Park District, to discuss Vendor performance. If the Park District determines in its reasonable opinion that operations are not consistent with appropriate standards of health, sanitation, safety, quality and reliability, the Park District may terminate the Agreement as set forth above in Section 11 for cause.
- 26. **Time:** Time is of the essence for all matters concerning this Agreement.

- 27. Non-Discrimination: In connection with performance of this Agreement, Vendor agrees not to discriminate against any employee, applicant for employment, customer or patron because of age, race, religion, color, handicap, sex, physical condition, developmental disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin. This provision shall include, but is not limited to, the following: employment, promotion, demotion or transfer, recruitment or compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. Vendor further agrees to take affirmative steps to ensure Equal Employment Opportunities. Vendor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available for applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of this paragraph.
- 28. <u>Jurisdiction:</u> This Agreement shall be governed by laws of the State of Illinois.

 Venue for all actions hereunder shall be Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, Lake County,

 Illinois. Any and all actions brought on behalf of Vendor under this agreement shall be commenced within one year of conduct or actions giving rise to the action.
- 29. Freedom of Information Act: Vendor agrees to maintain all records and documents for projects of the District in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. In addition, Vendor shall produce records which are responsive to a request received by the District under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") so that the District may provide records to those requesting them within the time frames required. If additional time is necessary to

compile records in response to a request, then Vendor shall so notify the District and if possible, the District shall request an extension so as to comply with the Act. In the event that the District is found to have not complied with the FOIA due to Vendor failure to produce documents or otherwise appropriately respond to a request under the Act, then Vendor shall indemnify and hold the District harmless, and pay all amounts determined to be due including but not limited to fines, costs, attorneys' fees and penalties.

EXHIBIT D INSURANCE COVERAGE LIQUOR – SALE/SERVING

Concessionaire shall procure and maintain for the duration of this Concession Agreement insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with Concessionaire's operation and use of the Licensed Space. The cost of such insurance shall be borne by Concessionaire.

A. Commercial General and Umbrella Liability Insurance

Concessionaire shall maintain commercial general liability (CGL) and, if necessary, commercial umbrella insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence. If such CGL insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this location.

CGL insurance shall be written on Insurance Services Office (ISO) occurrence form CG 00 01 10 93, or a substitute form providing equivalent coverage, and shall cover liability arising from premises, operations, independent contractors, products-completed operations, personal injury and advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract (including the tort liability of another assumed in a business contract).

Liquor liability coverage and product liability coverage is also to be provided with a limit not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

Park District shall be included as an insured under the CGL, using ISO additional insured endorsement CG 20 26 or a substitute providing equivalent coverage, and under the commercial umbrella, if any. This insurance shall apply as primary insurance with respect to any other insurance or self-insurance afforded to Park District.

B. Business Auto and Umbrella Liability Insurance

If applicable, Concessionaire shall maintain business auto liability and, if necessary, commercial umbrella liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident. Such insurance shall cover liability arising out of any auto including owned, hired and non-owned autos.

Business auto insurance shall be written on Insurance Services Office (ISO) form CA 00 01, CA 00 05, CA 00 12, CA 00 20, or a substitute form providing equivalent liability coverage. If necessary, the policy shall be endorsed to provide contractual liability coverage equivalent to that provided in the 1990 and later editions of CA 00 01.

C. Workers Compensation Insurance

If applicable, Concessionaire shall maintain workers compensation and employers liability insurance. The commercial umbrella and/or employers liability limits shall not be less than \$1,000,000 each accident for bodily injury by accident or \$1,000,000 each employee for bodily injury by disease.

D. If Park District has not been included as an insured under the CGL using ISO additional insured endorsement CG 20 26 under the Commercial General and Umbrella Liability Insurance required in this Contract, Concessionaire waives all rights against Park District and its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents for recovery of damages arising out of or incident to the Concessionaire's use of the premises.

E. General Insurance Provisions

1. Evidence of Insurance

Prior to using premises, Concessionaire shall furnish Park District with a certificate(s) of insurance and applicable policy endorsement(s), executed by a duly authorized representative of each insurer, showing compliance with the insurance requirements set forth above.

All certificates shall provide for 30 days' written notice to Park District prior to the cancellation or material change of any insurance referred to therein. Written notice to Park District shall be by certified mail, return receipt requested.

Failure of Park District to demand such certificate, endorsement or other evidence of full compliance with these insurance requirements or failure of Park District to identify a deficiency from evidence that is provided shall not be construed as a waiver of Concessionaire's obligation to maintain such insurance.

Park District shall have the right, but not the obligation, of prohibiting Concessionaire from occupying the premises until such certificates or other evidence that insurance has been placed in complete compliance with these requirements is received and approved by Park District.

Failure to maintain the required insurance may result in termination of this use agreement at Park District's option.

Concessionaire shall provide certified copies of all insurance policies required above within 10 days of Park Districts' written request for said copies.

2. Acceptability of Insurers

For insurance companies which obtain a rating from A.M. Best, that rating should be no less than A VII using the most recent edition of the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide. If the

Best's rating is less than A VII or a Best's rating is not obtained, Park District has the right to reject insurance written by an insurer it deems unacceptable.

3. Cross-Liability Coverage

If Concessionaire's liability policies do not contain the standard ISO separation of insureds provision, or a substantially similar clause, they shall be endorsed to provide cross-liability coverage.

4. Deductibles and Self-Insured Retentions

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to Park District. At the option of Park District, Concessionaire may be asked to eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retentions as respects Park District, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents or required to procure a bond guaranteeing payment of losses and other related costs including but not limited to investigations, claim administration and defense expenses

Subject: Consideration to Approve a Paddle Facility Reservation Agreement

Summary

At the December 13, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Park Board, the Park Board of Commissioners approved the Restricted Donation Agreement with Ronald Saslow at 2205 Skokie Valley Road (Lot 3) which includes the donation of a new Four-Season Air Supported Dome structure with Pickleball and Padel courts with certain restrictions and the Park District operating the facility upon completion. The new Dome may also feature a reception area, café, locker rooms and a pro shop. UPP Paddles, LLC, wishes to enter into an agreement to sell paddles, related products, and branded attire manufactured and sold by UPP (the "Products") to the Park District of Highland Park for sale in the Paddle Facility located at 2205 Skokie Valley Road, Highland Park, IL 60035.

Financial Impact

The Park District of Highland Park will reserve at least eighty-five percent (85%) of the total shelf space for UPP Products sold in the Paddle Facility. In consideration for the Reserved Shelf Space, UPP shall pay the PDHP \$100 per month, and will provide assistance with programming and tournaments at the Paddle Facility.

Recommendation

Staff and the Facility and Recreation Committee recommend the Park Board of Commissioners approve the Paddle Facility Reservation Agreement.

Subject: Consideration to Approve the Second Amendment to the Lot 3 Lease Agreement

Summary

In 2018 the Park District and the City of Highland Park approved a Lease Agreement for Lot 3 of the Highland Park Country Club, the parcel property known as the Highland Park Golf Learning Center and referred to as the "Enterprise Property" (Lease Agreement). Effective January 1, 2019, the Lease Agreement was amended in 2021 to address payment shares for proposed improvement at Lot 3 and Lot 4 pursuant to the Shared Use Agreement between the Park District of Highland Park and the City of Highland Park for Lot 4.

In compliance with the Lease Agreement, on September 30, 2023, the Park District released a Request for Proposals for an Agreement for Recreational Services of an Enterprise Facility at 2205 Skokie Valley Road, Highland Park, (Lot 3) in consideration for payment to the Park District of Highland Park. The Park District received three RFP submittals. At the October 25, 2023, Regular Meeting of the Park Board, the Park Board provided consensus to negotiate a Donor Agreement with Ronald Saslow, which includes the donation of a new Four-Season Air Supported Dome structure with Pickleball and Padel courts with certain restrictions and the Park District operating the facility upon completion. At the December 13, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Park Board, the Park Board of Commissioners approved the Restricted Donation Agreement with Ronald Saslow at 2205 Skokie Valley Road (Lot 3).

The Donor Agreement includes a contingency that the Lease Agreement be amended so that the term cannot be terminated without cause during the Term of the Donor Agreement. Therefore, the Park District desires to approve a second amendment to the Lot 3 Lease Agreement.
