

# COMMUNITY SURVEY FOR THE PARK DISTRICT OF HIGHLAND PARK

- These results are based on a survey of n=403 residents within the Park District of Highland Park (PDHP) boundaries, conducted between May 20<sup>th</sup> and June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Survey invitations were sent via email and USPS to a sample of PDHP households within the five communities. Respondents
  had the option to reply online, by hard copy (printed/mailed questionnaires), or by phone.

- The respondent data for the n=403 surveys were weighted to match US Census targets for Highland Park by region, gender, age, race/ethnicity, homeownership vs. renter status, and presence of children under age 18 in the household.
- The maximum margin of error for a sample of n=403 respondents is +/- 4.9% (at the 95% confidence level).\*



Regional Distribution of n=403 Respondents \*




#### **Overall Esteem (0-10 scale) with Park District of Highland Park**








#### **Overall Esteem (0-10 scale): Benchmark Comparisons**










# Dislikes/Improvements for PDHP (top multiple open-ended responses, n=319)







#### Does Your Household Feel Properly Represented/Included Within the PDHP's Offerings?








## **Value of PDHP Offerings (0-10 scale)**








#### **Overall Value (0-10 scale): Benchmark Comparisons**








#### **Most Frequently Used PDHP Parks/Facilities: Top Responses\***














#### **Top Reasons for Dissatisfaction: PDHP Facility/Park/Staff Experience (n=73 respondents)**









Q9. Why haven't you used/visited PDHP locations in the past 12 months? (multiple responses from n=32 non-users/non-visitors)

Q9. Why haven't you used/visited PDHP locations more often in the past 12 months? (multiple responses from n=369 recent users)















#### **Gap Analysis: Demand and Availability of Indoor Facilities**








#### **Top Priority for Indoor Facilities**








#### **Level of Demand/Need for Outdoor Facilities**








#### **Gap Analysis: Demand and Availability of <u>Outdoor</u> Facilities**













#### **Program/Event Participation in Past Year**








#### **Satisfaction with PDHP Programs/Events (0-10 scale)**




# Reasons for Dissatisfaction with PDHP Programs/Events (n=91)








#### **Level of Demand/Need for Program Options**









#### **Gap Analysis: Demand and Availability of Program Options**








#### **Top Priority for Program Options**








#### **Support/Opposition: Unfunded New/Improved Rec Facilities**








#### **Top Facility/Capital Improvement Priority**















